Climb Aboard the Holiday Express!

The Holiday Express is back! For years Solid Ground has invited the community to share the magic of the holidays with the families we serve. Holiday donors have brought joy to hundreds of children and relief to many parents who might have otherwise struggled to afford gifts. We are excited to invite our supporters back this year to share the holiday spirit!

Here's how it works! Each family at Solid Ground receives a Family Wish List, to which each family member can write up to three gifts they would like to receive. As we receive families' Wish Lists, we match families with community donors who shop for these families to fulfill their Wish Lists. If you would like to sign up to provide gifts for a family at Solid Ground, please complete our Holiday Express Donor Form. We'll start matching donors with families on November 1st.

Unable to shop for an entire family? No worries! Solid Ground also collects **monetary donations** as well as unwrapped gifts, and uses the items and funds that are collected to assemble gift packages for families that were unable to be matched with a donor.

In 2022, Solid Ground, with the support of community donors, was able to provide holiday gifts to 319 adults and children in 82 families.

Gifts and gift packages will be collected now through December 15th.


